Further to the below <u>works notification, issued on 18 October 2024</u>, delivery has been rescheduled to Wednesday, November 6.

Traffic controllers will be placed at the McGrath Lane entry from Tongarra Road and at the fenced area at the rear of Albion Park Public School from 6 am to 12 pm.

A mobile crane will arrive on site prior to work starting at 7 am.

Temporary fencing will remain in place until the installation is complete and contractors determine it is safe to remove and reopen the area.

Dear neighbour,

A new demountable classroom will be installed at Albion Park Public School over 4 weeks, starting Monday 28 October.

Contractors will access the school via McGrath Lane.

The delivery, which will require 5 trucks and a mobile crane, will take place in 1 day.

Delivery is expected during the week of 4 November and is dependent on weather conditions. We will update you when the details are finalised.

Temporary fencing will be installed from 28 October to ensure clear access.

The fence will run along the NSW Department of Education's land boundary, outside the existing perimeter fence and several metres closer towards McGrath Lane (see map).

Vehicles will be required to park in another location during these works.

Permanent fencing will be installed at a later date to accurately reflect the boundary.
