

# Anna Bay Public School

## Works notification | 5 June 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

Recently we visited Anna Bay Public School to investigate claims of mould on the carpet in Building F administration interview room.

NSW Health advises that mould spores are present virtually everywhere, both indoors and outdoors, and mould is part of a group of very common organisms called fungi that also include mushrooms and yeast.

In addition to mould, we discovered vinyl tiles under the carpet that contain bonded asbestos.

The interview room has been isolated from students and staff until work to remove the mould and asbestos is done on Saturday and 13 and Sunday 14 June 2026. This work will include:

- removing the existing carpet and vinyl tiles
- repairing a water damaged window and wall coverings
- installing new carpet.

All work involving mould and asbestos containing materials will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws and completed by experienced contractors. Once the work is finished, the room will be inspected by an independent hygienist before reopening for usual school activities.
