Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.5 billion for maintenance and local upgrades.

Ashford Central School facilities upgrade

As part of this investment, Ashford Central School will receive a share of \$4.2 million funding allocated to local schools to upgrade learning and teaching facilities.

The allocation will be spent on air conditioning (AC) which includes:

- installing an additional AC unit in classroom 1 (AR0008) in Building A
- replacing a faulty AC unit in Food Technology classroom
- adding another AC unit, and associated ducting, to Building E.

This work is expected to be completed by March, weather and other conditions permitting.
