

# Baryulgil Public School

## Works notification | 20 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Department of Education regularly inspects and maintains its assets.

On Monday 17 March 2025 an independent hygienist conducted an inspection at Baryulgil Public School as part of our proactive Asbestos Resurvey Program.

During this audit they found dust suspected to contain asbestos in the electrical switchboard room in Building A.

The room is usually locked and not accessed by staff or students.

The independent hygienist organised a sample for testing, locked the room and organised signage to ensure it remained inaccessible.

The material has been confirmed as friable asbestos. Friable asbestos can be crumbled, pulverised or reduced to a powder by hand pressure.

Work to clean the dust and remediate the room was done on Wednesday 19 March 2025 outside of school hours.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures were in place while work was done.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The electrical switchboard room was inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it had been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate was issued before signage was removed.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
