Works notification | 23 April 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

We would like to provide you with an update on the works notifications sent on [Tuesday 31 March 2026](#) regarding the drinking water quality test results for Baryulgil Public School. We are pleased to inform you that the necessary works have now been completed by qualified and accredited contractors.

Following the completion of these works, the affected water supply outlets connected to the underground pipe was re-tested by an independent hygienist. The results confirm that the water quality now meets the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

Access to the water supply outlets next to Building D has been restored and can now be used by students and staff.

CCTV installation

We also wish to advise that we will be installing a closed-circuit TV (CCTV) security system at Baryulgil Public School. The purpose of these cameras is to monitor entry into the school premises and add a level of security for students and staff.

As part of work, CCTV cameras will be installed outside of the Administration Building.

This planned work involves drilling into linings which are known to contain asbestos materials as identified on the Schools Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

As a precaution, the areas will be isolated to restrict access to students, staff and school visitors while work is being done. All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours with safety measures such as PPE, air monitoring and temporary fencing in place.

This work is scheduled to start in Term 2 and is expected to be finished by the end of term. Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.
