

# Beresfield Public School

Works notification | 7 November 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are refurbishing the toilets in Building A at Beresfield Public School. In preparation for the upgrade, we will be removing material known to contain asbestos in the walls and ceiling panels as per the school's asbestos register.

Work to remove the material will take place on Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 November 2023.

The building continues to be used as the materials are undisturbed.

The toilets in Building A will be cordoned off before the work starts, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place. The toilets will remain cordoned off until the toilet upgrade work is complete in early 2024.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The building will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate before the rooms are re-opened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
