

# Beresfield Public School

Works notification | 14 December 2022

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Upcoming maintenance works is planned to replace a window in the staff room at Beresfield Public School. This work will involve working with asbestos containing material in window fittings.

The material is bonded asbestos, which means it is attached to other material such as cement or vinyl and cannot be crumbled by light pressure. As a precaution the window has been boarded up. Please be assured the room is currently safe for use.

Work will take place during the summer school holidays on Tuesday 17 January 2023. Before works begin, the area will be cordoned off, safety measures and monitoring will be put in place. The area will remain out of bounds to any staff or students who may visit the school over the holidays until the removal and associated maintenance work is completed.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
