Works notification | 12 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Bigga Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

This biannual routine testing was carried out on Wednesday 5 November 2025. The results, received on Friday 7 November 2025, identified contamination in the tank water supply used at the school.

Testing confirmed the presence of E-coli in the bubbler station of Building A. We are still awaiting test results for the presence of lead and copper and will provide the school community with an update as soon as we receive these.

As a precautionary safety measure, access to the affected bubbler station has been restricted. Signage is in place to remind students and staff not to use the bubblers.

We are working with an independent hygienist to investigate any necessary remediation work. All remediation works will be carried out by qualified contractors, and additional testing will be conducted following this work to ensure the water is safe for use.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of our school community remain our highest priority.
