School holiday works notification - Summer | 2025/2026

Dear staff, parents, carers, and neighbours,

School holidays are the ideal time to undertake maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the upcoming holidays

We will be working at your school during the summer holidays.

We are removing a demountable building located outside the hall on the western side of Ocean Shores Public School. This demountable is no longer required by the school and will not be replaced. This will result in more outdoor space for use by the school's support unit.

Due to the age and condition of the demountable and the known presence of bonded asbestos, on-site controlled demolition was determined to be the safest and most practical solution for removal. This will take place from Tuesday 13 January 2026.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done including encapsulation of the demountable while asbestos removal is taking place. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once the hygienist has confirmed all asbestos has been removed, the demountable will be dismantled and removed from site.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
