Demountable Removal Update | 22 March 2024

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are removing a demountable at Birchgrove Public School and transporting it to a storage facility.

The demountable has undisturbed asbestos, which is in the school's asbestos register.

As a requirement of transportation, the contractor, ProGroup, have placed a precautionary asbestos warning sign on the fencing.

The work is being done under the safe work conditions for releasing a building from a school site, which requires a sticker to be attached notifying that the building contains asbestos during transport.

There is no asbestos removal work being done on the building.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority.
