As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, a project is underway to improve accessibility and modify infrastructure at Boambee Public School.

Start of construction

The construction will start from Friday 20 March 2026. These works will provide disabled access and modify existing infrastructure throughout the school. We expect the project to be finished by the end of Term 2 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

The project includes:

- Site establishment and set up of a secure construction site and establishing a materials handling area
- Accessibility upgrades including stairs, ramps, covered walkways, access carpark and ambulant amenities across the school

Managing construction impacts
