## Boambee Public School Works notification | 7 September 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The NSW Department of Education regularly inspects and maintains its assets to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our school communities.

We are replacing the air conditioning unit in the library demountable at Boambee Public School.

This work involves disturbing ceiling sheets suspected to contain asbestos.

In preparation for this work, we engaged an independent hygienist to test the ceiling panels.

Testing confirmed the ceiling sheets contain bonded asbestos. The sheets are currently undisturbed and the library can continue to be used. The area will be made out of bounds before the work starts.

Work to remove the ceiling sheets and install the new air conditioner will take place on Saturday 21 September 2024.

All work will be done outside of school hours in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

An independent hygienist will inspect the area once the work is complete, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the library is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
