Braidwood Central School Works notification | 18 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Following our <u>works notification on 21 February 2025</u>, we will be removing vinyl tiles and replacing carpets in the Building G storage room and hallway at Braidwood Central School.

Testing conducted by an independent hygienist on Friday 28 February confirmed the tiles contain bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

While classes are continuing in the building, both the room and hallway will remain cordoned off until remediation is completed.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside of school hours on Saturday 22 March. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The areas will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated and clearance certificates will be issued before carpet is relayed.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
