Braidwood Central School Works notification | 4 April 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

During <u>scheduled repairs to the sub floor footings in Building G</u> at Braidwood Central School, a contractor identified suspected bonded asbestos in the vinyl tiles underneath the carpet in the deputy principal's office and adjacent hallway.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

While classes are continuing in the building, the hallway and office will remain cordoned off until remediation is completed.

Office resources have been relocated to another room until work is complete.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists on Saturday April 5 in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

The room and hallway will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before the carpet is relayed.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
