Dear staff, parents and carers,

Due to the heritage status of Building A at Broken Hill North Public School, which was built in 1927, the department has conducted monthly condition inspections since mid-2023.

During the most recent inspection, during the Winter School Holidays, an engineer advised remediation work is required.

Changes to school operations

On Tuesday 23 July 2024, we began relocating Building A classrooms and the library.

The library is being relocated to the old hall in Building C while the classrooms are being relocated across unused teaching spaces in both Building C and Building F.

While we are waiting for further recommendations to plan remediation work, access to Building A will be restricted to students from Tuesday 30 July 2024. Staff will still have access to their facilities on Building A.

We are working with school leadership this week to relocate staff facilities and resources, including the installation of a dedicated demountable building for staff amenities.

Staff will begin relocating once the demountable has been installed.

Fencing will be installed around the building to prevent access once all resources and facilities have been relocated.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

We will keep the community updated.
