## Community update | April 2026

### High school enrolment information for Brookvale Public School families

From 2026 intake areas across the northern beaches have changed.

As part of these updates, in 2027 and 2028, the department is prioritising Brookvale Public School students who make a non-local application to enrol at:

- The Forest High School,
- Northern Beaches Secondary College (NBSC) Balgowlah Boys Campus, and
- NBSC Mackellar Girls Campus.

This means Brookvale Public School students have guaranteed non-local access to these 3 schools, which have sufficient non-local Enrolment Availability to accept students from Brookvale Public School across 2027 and 2028.

#### Can I send my child to NBSC Cromer Campus?

Yes. If you live in the intake area for Brookvale Public School, your designated local school is NSBC Cromer Campus and your family has guaranteed co-educational local enrolment.

#### How do I enrol my child at The Forest High School, NBSC Balgowlah Boys or Mackellar Girls?

#### How are new intake areas developed?

The new intake areas have been developed through a consultative process with schools and communities. A number of relevant factors were considered to inform the development of the new intake areas including enrolment trends, opportunities to align with primary school local intake areas, public transport access, the size and utilisation rate of schools, the number of students living in each proposed intake area, and the physical capacity of schools to enrol students.
