Dear staff, parents, carers, and neighbours,

We would like to provide you with an update on the replacement of demountable buildings at Cambewarra Public School.

On Thursday 4 July and Friday 5 July 2024, we will remove 4 of the 5 existing buildings being replaced with refurbished demountables.

The buildings being removed include 3 classrooms and one administration/staffroom building.

The library building will be removed at a later date.

Standard construction working hours are 7 am to 6 pm, Monday to Friday.

Traffic management measures will be in place to coordinate the transfer of a crane to and from the school site and all associated truck movements.

To minimise congestion on Goorama Drive and Kalinga Street, for drop off and pick up of children, parents and carers are requested to use the southern school entry – near the pedestrian crossing on Main Road.
