

Cambewarra Public School

Works notification | 14 June 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We would like to provide you with an update on mould investigation and testing work carried out at Cambewarra Public School.

On Friday 31 May, suspected mould was found in 3 demountable buildings - the staffroom, library and a Year 2 classroom (2R).

On Thursday 6 June, an independent hygienist investigated and carried out air testing in the affected areas.

We received recommendations on Thursday 13 June to close the staffroom and library buildings immediately.

Staff are now using the principal's office as a temporary staffroom until other arrangements can be made.

The Year 2 demountable will require some remediation, however, the independent hygienist confirmed it can continue to be used.

We are also waiting for further detailed remediation recommendations.

All work involving hazardous materials will take place outside of school hours, with safety measures in place while work is being done.

All inspections and remediation works will be conducted in accordance with recommendations from the independent hygienist.

Use and access to the buildings will be restricted until a clearance certificate is received.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep the community updated.
