Works notification | 20 June 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We would like to provide you with an update on the actions taken by the NSW Department of Education in response to recent mould investigations at Cambewarra Public School.

On Friday 14 June 2024, we informed you about the closure of 2 demountable buildings – the staffroom and library – due to the presence of mould, on the advice of an independent hygienist.

On Wednesday 19 June 2024, visible mould was found in 2 other demountables – 2R and 1N classrooms.

As a precautionary measure, these buildings have been closed.

Students and staff, who normally use these rooms, have been relocated to other areas of the school to continue their face-to-face learning.

The department can now confirm replacement of affected demountable buildings at the school.

The resources and furniture in the 4 closed demountables will now be individually assessed by an independent hygienist.

We will be in contact with staff regarding the retrieval of their personal items as this information becomes available.
