Works notification | 3 July 2024

Dear Cambewarra Public School neighbours,

We would like to provide you with information on work to replace demountable buildings at Cambewarra Public School.

Removal of old buildings

On Thursday 4 July and Friday 5 July 2024, we will remove 4 demountable buildings. These demountables are in the northeast corner of the school, near the school's Kalinga Street entrance.

Work involves transporting a mobile crane to safely lift the demountable buildings onto trucks.

Entry and exit of construction vehicles will be from Main Road (east) via Goorama Drive and Kalinga Street.

No trucks will be parked on Goorama Drive or Kalinga Street during this work.

The school community has been asked to use the school entrance at Main Road (west of Goorama Drive) to minimise congestion on Kalinga Street.

Installation of new buildings

The installation of the new demountable buildings will commence on Friday 5 July 2024 and continue during the school holidays, weather permitting.

Once the demountable buildings are in place, additional construction works will involve connecting necessary services, such as plumbing and electrical connections.

Working hours

All works will take place between 7 am and 6 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

We will work to ensure that all works are carried out safely and efficiently and to minimise impacts to the community.
