Works notification | 6 September 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers, and neighbours,

We would like to provide you with information on upcoming Spring School Holiday work at Cambewarra Public School.

Tree trimming

An arborist will trim high branches on a spotted gum to allow for the removal of the school's old library demountable.

This work will take place over two weekends leading up to the school holidays, 7-8 September, and 21-22 September 2024.

We will ensure we do not disturb the tree's known natural habit for parakeets during this work.

Removal of old library demountable

On Tuesday 1 October, we will remove the demountable located in the south-east corner of the school grounds.

Work involves a mobile crane safely lifting sections of the building onto trucks.

Entry and exit of construction vehicles will be from Main Road (east) via Goorama Drive and Kalinga Street. No trucks will be parked on Goorama Drive or Kalinga Street during this work.

Working hours

We will ensure works – which will take place between 7 am and 6 pm – are carried out safely and efficiently to minimise impacts to the community.
