Camden Public School Project Update | September 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Building A upgrade

We are excited to share an update on ongoing works that are underway to upgrade the front entrance of Camden Public School on John Street.

The planned upgrades include:

- construction of a new foyer at the current entry of Building A
- installation of automatic sliding glass doors
- · addition of a veranda
- construction of stairs and an accessibility ramp
- concrete work for the ramp installation
- · installation of guttering and drainage systems
- · installation of seating
- installation of soft fall material, gravel and gardens.

Work began on Monday 25 August 2025 and is expected to be finished by early December 2025, weather and other conditions permitting.


Changes to access to Building A

During this work, the current entry doors to the administration area of Building A will be closed within the fenced off work site. Students, staff and visitors to the school will access Building A via the doors near the staffroom.

A temporary access ramp will be installed to the doors at the southern end of Building A (near the hall) for students, staff and members of the school community who need it. Please see the map overleaf for more details.







What to expect

During the works, there may be some construction noise as there will be heavy machinery, including cranes, concrete trucks, and steel delivery vehicles accessing the school. As such, some noise and disruption can be expected throughout the construction period.

During this time there will be an increase in truck and contractor vehicle movements in nearby streets. All construction vehicles will access the construction site via Gate A on John Street.

There will be no changes to student drop off and pick up zones and staff carpark.

Contractors will have noise and dust mitigation measures in place and will monitor noise levels throughout the construction period. Noisy works will be conducted outside of school hours as much as possible to minimise any disruption to the school and surrounding community.

Work hours

In accordance with the <u>Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 (POEO Act)</u> and Camden Council guidelines, construction works will take place **Monday to Saturday between 7 am and 5 pm with no work permitted on Sundays or public holidays**.
