## Works notification

Further to the works notification below issued on 9 November 2022, works at Cammeray Public School have been rescheduled to allow the Sydney Saturday School of Japanese to hold their fete that has been scheduled for this Saturday 12 November 2022.

The remediation works will now take place outside of school hours over two consecutive weekends starting on Sunday 13 November and Saturday 19 November and Sunday 20 November 2022, weather permitting.

### 9 November 2022

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Further to our notification on 18 October 2022, a project is underway to remediate the north east corner of the school site behind the sports court. The remediation works will involve capping the area with a geofabric marker layer, clean soil and synthetic turf.

The remediation works will take place outside of school hours over two consecutive weekends between Saturday 12 November and Sunday 13 November and Saturday 19 November and Sunday 20 November 2022, weather permitting. Work hours will be 8am to 4pm, Saturday and 8 am to 2 pm, Sunday.

The area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area is cordoned off within the worksite and safety measures will be implemented including air monitoring. As a precaution, workers will also be wearing personal protective equipment including hazmat suits.

The area will be inspected to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

In the interim, any fragments of suspected asbestos containing material identified within the worksite are being removed in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan, and clearance certificates provided by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation during this important work.
