## Brisbania Public School Works notification | 8 May 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of planned maintenance, we will be removing and replacing partition walls in the student toilets in Building B (a general learning block) at Brisbania Public School.

The partition walls in these toilets contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged'.

Work involving asbestos-containing materials will be done outside of school hours on Saturday 17 May 2025.

During the asbestos removal work there will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
