Dear staff, parents and carers,

We are delighted to advise you of upcoming renovations as we plan for growth at Charlestown Public School.

### Enrolment growth

The NSW Department of Education plans for growth by delivering educational infrastructure to meet current and future enrolment needs.

Charlestown Public School enrolments have been steadily increasing over the past 10 years.

There is significant high-density development in the school catchment, and enrolments are forecast to continue this growth trend over coming years.

### Site assessment

To meet this growth, the department is reviewing accommodation requirements at the school. This requires careful consideration as the school has some constraints due to its size. We will share developments with you as more information becomes available.

We are committed to student health and wellbeing, and have looked at expanding the student toilet block as a priority.

### Project details

As part of our early site assessments, we have identified an opportunity to optimise an unused space between the existing student bathroom block to increase the number of toilets onsite.

We are currently developing a concept plan, and are planning to build one-person cubicles in the space identified. The soft fall area where the volleyball net is will be relocated as part of the project.

The installation of one-person cubicles is common practice across NSW public schools, because they offer privacy and comfort.

The new toilets delivered as part of the upgrade will feature new fixtures, tiling, basins and lighting. This is a great initiative for our school community.

This project is expected to be completed for Day 1, Term 2 2026, weather and other conditions permitting.
