Works notification | 20 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Conargo Public School as part of our routine water testing program.

Findings have detected bacteria and lead in samples collected from a tap in the staff kitchen, beside the library.

As a precautionary safety measure, access will be restricted to the tap outlets.

Signage will be in place to remind students and staff not to access the tap. Bottled water is being supplied for staff as needed.

We are working with an independent hygienist to undertake any remediation work required.

All work will be carried out by qualified contractors, and we will undertake additional testing at the school following the work to ensure the water can continue to be used.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
