Concord Public School Works notification | 27 June 2024

Dear neighbours,

As part of planned maintenance, we are removing and replacing a section of eave sheeting in Building E at Concord Public School. This involves working with bonded asbestos-containing material in the eaves, as listed in the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that if bonded asbestos is mixed with cement or other hard bonding materials, and in good condition, it is likely to be low-risk.

Work will take place on Saturday 6 July. The area will be cordoned off before the work starts, and safety measures and air monitoring put in place.

All work will be done outside of school hours, in accordance with work, health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. We will keep the community updated.
