Works notification | 21 February 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Following a vandalism incident, upcoming maintenance works to repair damages to the boys and girls toilets in Block I at Cooerwull Public School will involve working with assumed asbestos containing material inside the toilet partition walls.

As a safety precaution, the toilets have been cordoned off and will remain out of bounds to students and staff until remediation is completed.

We will keep the community updated and inform you of the date of remediation works when this is confirmed.

The area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is re-opened to students and staff.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
