Works notification | 19 August 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Further to the [Works Notification on 2 July](#) regarding the drinking water quality test results for Coorabell Public School, remediation work has been completed by a qualified and accredited tradesperson following advice by an independent hygienist.

Re-testing of the affected tap outlets by an independent hygienist has returned results that meet the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#).

Access to the tap outlets in the following locations has been restored and can be used again by students and staff:

- practical activities area of the Year 1/2 demountable classroom
- external practical activities area outside the library
- handbasin of the staff toilet.

The tap outlet in the practical activities area of the Year 5/6 demountable classroom requires additional work before access can be restored. This is due to the sample not meeting the requirements of the [Australian Drinking Water Guidelines](#) after the initial cleaning, disinfection, and re-testing.

The health and wellbeing of students, staff and the local community is our highest priority.

We will keep the community updated.
