

Cooranbong Public School

Works notification | 10 March 2025

Dear neighbours,

As part of planned maintenance, we will be replacing the existing fencing along the school perimeter between your property and Cooranbong Public School.

Cooranbong Public School is considered 'inclosed land' as indicated in the [Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 \(ILP Act\)](#).

By installing new fencing, we will provide greater safety and security for our students, staff and the wider community.

The NSW Department of Education will cover the cost of the work. You will not be required to make any financial contribution.

We ask for your feedback about the type of shared boundary fencing between your property and Cooranbong Public School. The 2 choices of fencing available are:

- 2.1 metre high, diplomat style fencing, that is, a security style featuring vertical metal bars and spear tops or
- 1.8 metre high Colorbond fencing, that is, a brand of pre-painted steel fencing.
