## Cundletown Public School Works notification | 1 September 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

We will be renovating the senior student toilets in Building C, the block containing the hall and library, at Cundletown Public School.

As part of this work, we will be removing the cubicle partition walls which are known to contain bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

Work involving asbestos-containing materials will be completed outside of school hours on Saturday 6 September 2025. The toilets are accessible up until the date of works.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures including air monitoring, fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment will be in place while works are being done. All works will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The Building C toilets will be inspected by the independent hygienist to confirm they have been fully remediated, and a clearance certificate will be issued before construction can continue.

Work hours for the ongoing toilet works are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines.

Alternative toilets are available for students to use while works are being done.

Toilet refurbishments are expected to be finished in November 2025, weather and other conditions permitting.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
