

# Dee Why Public School

## Works notification | 23 June 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

We will be repairing a small garden area which has eroded near the Regent Street side of Dee Why Public School.

This garden area is already out of bounds, sectioned off and concealed from the street. The location is known to have contaminated soil and is listed on the school's asbestos register.

Due to erosion, bonded asbestos-containing materials have been exposed in this area.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

The repairs have been scheduled outside of school hours on Saturday 28 June 2025. An independent hygienist will undertake air monitoring.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
