Works notification | 22 September 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

A small fibro sheeting suspected to contain asbestos material has been found on the ground on the eastern fence line behind the demountable units at Dora Creek Public School.

We are following all the advice and protocols of independent asbestos hygienists and other experts.

As a precaution, the area around where the material was found has been fenced and secured so that it is out of bounds and closed to anyone on site.

Testing will be conducted by an independent hygienist to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

If remediation is necessary, this work will be carried out in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited independent asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The area will be inspected to ensure it has been fully remediated and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and local community is our highest priority, and we will continue to keep the community updated.
