Works notification | 18 May 2026

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.

We are removing a demountable classroom building located beside the toilet block on the east side of school grounds at Dubbo North Public School.

When no longer needed, demountables are removed to return open play spaces for students to enjoy. This demountable is no longer required by the school.

Due to the age, condition and known presence of bonded asbestos as listed on the School's Asbestos Management Plan, the demountable will be safely demolished onsite before it is securely removed.

All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours between 8 am to 5 pm on Thursday 14 May 2026, with safety measures such as PPE, air monitoring in place, and temporary fencing to restrict public access.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will take place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

Once removed, an independent hygienist will inspect the area and confirm the area can be reopened for school activities.
