# Dudley Public School | Works notification February 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

Since our last update on 12 December 2024, we are excited to announce that the final remediation works for Dudley Public School are now complete, and all outdoor areas have been opened for use.

The Remediation Action Plan has been fulfilled, and the project has been finalised, including:

- remediated and turfed outdoor playground space
- a new ramp that provides access through the school and play areas, including adding balustrades and a handrail
- increased accessibility
- new landscaped garden areas
- designated soft fall areas.

The Remediation Action Plan was the result of a site investigation carried out in 2022 that guided the remediation of soil from asbestos material.

An independent hygienist inspected the school and issued a clearance certificate to reopen all playground spaces.

We are thrilled to have delivered this project for the Dudley Public School community.
