Works notification | 2 June 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are preparing to upgrade the hall at Dudley Public School. The hall upgrade includes refurbishing the flooring, windows, and painting.

Before we can start work on the upgrade, we need to remove a window frame and this will involve working with asbestos containing material in the frame. The window frame is currently undisturbed and in good condition.

The window frame will be removed on Thursday 8 June 2023. All work involving asbestos containing materials will take place outside of school hours, with additional safety measures and monitoring in place before the work starts.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The hall will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been fully remediated, and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate before the hall upgrade work starts.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
