

# Dunedoo Central School

## Works notification | 14 January 2025

Dear parents, carers and staff,

In addition to works notifications issued on [29 November](#) and [9 December 2024](#), we can provide a further update on roof works at Dunedoo Central School.

Work to address water ingress issues in Building C, which begin on 28 January 2025, will be completed before students return to school on 6 February.

### Work overview

- replacing exterior eave sheets with compressed fibro cement sheeting
- installing overflows into 2 existing box gutters.

Samples taken by an independent hygienist on 18 December from the existing eave sheets, which are located inside both box gutters, confirmed the presence of bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.

### Share our Space update

Access to the school site and its facilities, as part of the [Share our Space program](#), will be restricted for the remainder of the Summer School Holidays while this work occurs.

Asbestos removal works will take place on 28 January in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place while work is being done.

All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

An independent hygienist will issue a clearance certificate after the asbestos-containing sheets are removed, allowing roof works to continue.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
