Works notification | 25 March 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

We would like to update you on the works notification issued below. Test results confirmed bonded asbestos in the storage and community activities room in Building D at Duri Public School.

Work to remove the subfloor vinyl tiles will start on Saturday 28 March 2026 between 8 am and 1 pm. Asbestos-containing materials (ACMs) are products that include asbestos fibres bonded into other materials, like wall and floor sheets, making them safe when intact.

This location is not in an area identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP). The register will be updated to include this recent find as required.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The storage and community activities room in Building D will be inspected by the independent hygienist, and a clearance certificate will be issued before the area is reopened.

Notification issued on Monday 2 March 2026

Dear parents, staff and carers,

During planned maintenance works in a storage and community activities room in Building D on Thursday 5 February 2026 at Duri Public School, a contractor lifted the floor coverings to inspect the condition of the subfloor. They identified green vinyl tiles suspected to contain bonded asbestos.

The building was immediately closed and locked from students and staff.

As a precaution an independent hygienist attended the site on Tuesday 24 February 2026 to inspect the room and collect samples for testing.

The room will remain closed until test results are received and further advice is provided by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities. We will keep the community updated.
