## Panania Public School Works notification | 5 March 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

Work to repair roofs damaged during recent storms is underway at Panania Public School.

Part of the repair work included the removal of asbestos-containing eave sheets from Buildings B and C, which are listed in the school's asbestos register.

Work involving asbestos-containing materials took place on Saturday 1 and Sunday 2 March 2025.

Safety measures were in place while the work was done, including temporary fencing, signage and air monitoring.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists, in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

The eaves were inspected by the independent hygienist and a clearance certificate was issued to confirm both have been fully remediated.

Roof repair work has resumed and is expected to be complete by Day 1 Term 2.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
