

The Entrance Public School

Works notification | 27 October 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

We are installing a 10-metre drainage pipe as overflow for an inground water tank in the north-west corner of The Entrance Public School grounds.

The area of work is currently covered in geofabric and is known to contain fragments of bonded asbestos containing material in grounds, identified as part of the school's site-specific Asbestos Management Plan.

Work to install the pipes will take place outside of school hours, on Saturday 11 November 2023.

During the work to install drainage pipes the area will be cordoned off with additional safety measures and monitoring put in place.

Work will be done in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations, the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and the school's site-specific management plan. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

Following the installation work, the area will be inspected by an independent hygienist to confirm it has been managed in accordance with the site-specific management plan.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
