Works notification | 15 July 2025

Dear staff, parents, carers and neighbours,

On Thursday 10 July 2025, strong winds caused a tree to fall and damage the perimeter fence near the covered outdoor learning area along Ernest Street, outside Woodport Public School.

No one was onsite at the time. Additional security measures were arranged while the fence was affected.

On the same day, arborists removed the tree safely and the debris was cleared. The fence was secured to prevent any unauthorised access and to maintain safety. Replacement panels of the same height, colour and style have been ordered and will be installed in Term 3.

This tree had been identified in an arborist report received on Tuesday 8 July 2025 for removal, scheduled on Tuesday 15 July 2025. The unexpected weather caused the tree to fall before this work could be done.

We will continue to monitor the health and safety of all trees on school grounds.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
