## Ettalong Public School Works notification | 10 March 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of regular maintenance, we have repaired a cracked window in a classroom in Building A at Ettalong Public School.

The putty material in this window frame contains bonded asbestos as listed on the school's asbestos register asbestos. NSW Health explains that 'living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged.'

The window was inspected prior to the repair work being done to confirm that the putty was undisturbed. Work to repair the window and remove the window frame material took place on Saturday 8 March 2025.

All work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours. All work involving asbestos-containing material was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

All work was completed by licensed asbestos contractors and monitored by independent hygienists.

The classroom was inspected by the independent hygienist and clearance provided to continue using the room.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
