

Eugowra Community Children’s Centre (ECCC)

Works notification | 23 January 2023

The Eugowra Community Children’s Centre (ECCC) was significantly impacted by flooding on the 14 November 2022.

In response to significant flooding impacting Eugowra Community Childcare Centre (ECCC), School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) is working to establish temporary facilities for students and staff for their quick return to learning in 2023.

Works are currently underway for the temporary site for ECCC to be erected within the grounds of the Eugowra Showground.

We’re pleased to inform that this work is tracking well for the temporary preschool to be operational during Term 1 2023.

Next steps

The delivery of demountable classroom buildings is anticipated to commence this week, with all buildings (13 module buildings, 4 module buildings and 2 storage containers) to be delivered on Tuesday 24 January 2023.

The commissioning of the buildings will commence soon after.

Please expect areas surrounding certain parts of the showground to be busy on Tuesday, as the buildings are placed securely on site.

In the coming days, SINSW will also complete a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) at the ECCC’s temporary location within the Eugowra Showground. In conjunction with our partners at Cabonne Council, SINSW will continue to work to ensure the safety and peace of mind of the local community.

The timing of all work will be subject to local weather conditions, access, and availability of trades services, and buildings.
