Frenchs Forest Public School School holiday works notification – Winter | 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

The school holidays are the ideal time to complete maintenance and project work across the state without disrupting learning.

Planned work over the winter break

We will be working at your school during the Winter School Holidays – from the end of the school day on Friday 4 July 2025 up to Day 1 Term 3 (Tuesday 22 July 2025).

We are repairing and repainting the interiors of buildings K, O and P at Frenchs Forest Public School.

The ceiling linings in a corridor and school bag storage area in Building K, used by the outside of school hours (OOSH) care service, are known to contain bonded asbestos, as listed on the school's asbestos register. This material will be removed.

NSW Health explains that "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

During the works the OOSH and vacation care program will be running, however the program will be temporarily relocated to other spaces in Building H.

Work involving asbestos-containing materials will be completed outside of school hours. There will be air monitoring, temporary fencing, signage and workers wearing personal protective equipment at the school while this is taking place. During the repainting, several rooms will be isolated.

All work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by an independent hygienist.

The health, safety and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
