## Works notification | 28 November 2025

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 25 November 2025, fragments of material suspected to contain asbestos were identified on the field backing onto Chesham Parade at Glenfield Public School.

The area has been fenced off since Tuesday 25 November 2025 and remains inaccessible to students and staff.

This location is not in area listed in the school's asbestos register. The register will be updated to include this recent find.

NSW Health explains the "living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged".

An independent hygienist attended the school on Wednesday 26 November 2025 to complete testing and provide remediation advice.

The asbestos will be removed on Saturday 6 December 2025. All work involving asbestos-containing materials will take place outside school hours.

All work will be done in accordance with Work Health and Safety laws and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors and inspected by independent hygienists.

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.
