

Glenmore Road Public School

Community update | November 2024

Dear staff, parents and carers,

As part of the NSW Government's record \$1.5 billion investment in maintenance and local upgrades this financial year, we are delivering a series of projects at Glenmore Road Public School to support the school community.

These works are at various stages of delivery and include:

- Refurbishment of the Building A slate roof. Works started in July this year and were completed on Friday 20 September.
- Internal refurbishment of the Building A hall. A contractor has been appointed and works started on 30 September.
- Installation of a shade structure over the top playground synthetic grass area. The shade structure will be co-funded by the department and the school's P&C. As Glenmore Road Public School has heritage listed infrastructure on site, we have engaged a heritage consultant and incorporated their findings in the tender documentation. We expect to appoint a contractor within the coming weeks and finish installing the shade structure in time for students and staff to enjoy from Day 1 Term 1 2025.
- Landscaping of the rainforest area at the front of the school. This work will be fully funded by the P&C. A contractor has been appointed and work is expected to start before the end of the year.
- Upgrade of the air conditioning system. An initial electrical report has been completed and we are investigating the extent of the upgrade required.
