## Works notification | 10 February 2026

Dear staff, parents, carers and surrounding neighbours,

The health, safety and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority.

As part of the maintenance program at Goulburn Public School, we are undertaking works in Building M. These works started during the recent summer school holidays and are expected to continue throughout Term 1 2026.

Expected timeframes for upcoming works are outlined below, pending weather conditions:

- **Monday 9 to Friday 13 February 2026** – Internal plastering
- **Monday 16 to Wednesday 18 February 2026** – External cladding
- **Thursday 19 to Friday 20 February 2026** – Internal fit-out
- **Monday 23 to Friday 27 February 2026** – Internal and external painting
- **Thursday 26 February 2026** – Electrical and security works
- **Friday 27 February 2026** – Carpet installation

The dates of these works are approximate only and are subject to change.

We understand the proximity of the school to nearby residences and appreciate your patience while these works are completed. All activities will be managed to minimise disruption where possible.

Work vehicles will enter and exit from Clifford Street with traffic management in place during construction. Deliveries will occur outside of pick-up and drop-off periods. Work hours are between 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturday, in line with [NSW Environment Protection Authority guidelines](#).
