

# Goulburn Public School

## Works notification | 10 July 2025

Dear staff, parents, and carers,

On the afternoon of Friday 4 July 2025, an independent hygienist found suspected fragments of in-ground bonded asbestos in the staff car park at Goulburn Public School.

The fragments were removed for testing by the hygienist, and the area was cordoned off as a precautionary measure. Test results received on Tuesday 8 July 2025 confirmed the presence of bonded asbestos.

NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

The hygienist returned on Tuesday 8 July 2025 to conduct an inspection and no additional fragments were found.

The independent hygienist advised the staff carpark can reopen.

All inspection and removal work involving asbestos-containing materials took place outside of school hours.

All work was done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. Safety measures will be in place while work is being done.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of all members of our school and the local community are our highest priorities.
