

Granville Public School

Works notification | 4 March 2026

Dear staff, parents and carers,

On Tuesday 20 January 2026, contractors discovered, sheeting materials suspected to contain asbestos under the floor of the hall at Granville Public School.

This area was not identified on the School Asbestos Management Plan (SAMP).

The sheets were in good condition, and while the area was already inaccessible to staff and students, it was locked immediately.

Asbestos-containing materials (ACMs) are products that include asbestos fibres bonded into other materials, like wall and floor sheets, making them safe when intact. NSW Health explains that “living or working with asbestos, or just being around it, is a low risk to your health as long as the asbestos is in good condition and not damaged”.

On Saturday 7 March 2026, all suspected asbestos-containing materials will be removed under the guidance of an independent hygienist who will issue a clearance certificate before the area is reopened. Safety measures, including air monitoring, will be in place. All asbestos-related work will be done in accordance with work health and safety laws and the NSW Department of Education’s Asbestos Management Plan. All work will be completed by licensed asbestos contractors.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority.
