

Gravesend Public School

Works notification | 3 May 2023

Dear staff and parents/carers,

Drinking water quality testing was recently conducted at Gravesend Public School as part of planned maintenance.

Findings have detected some lead slightly above acceptable levels from an external tap on the eastern side of Block A, as well as from the staffroom sink in Block A. Testing has also detected some bacteria in samples collected from the same sink.

Precautionary safety measures have been put in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community. This includes restricting access to the taps.

As there has been no material detected elsewhere, drinking water can continue to be available for use from the school's remaining usage points. This is in line with the independent occupational hygienist advice. Bottled water will be supplied as an alternative for staff and students.

School Infrastructure NSW will now work with the independent occupational hygienist and the school to undertake any remediation work required. All work will be carried out by qualified contractors and School Infrastructure NSW will undertake additional testing at the school following the work to ensure the water is safe for use.

The health and safety of students and staff is the priority for the school and the NSW Department of Education. Department staff will continue working closely with NSW Health and the school leadership, to keep you updated on this matter.
